Proposal for two new Honorary Members

1. Marc Hockings

Marc Hockings has a long history of active involvement and leadership within IUCN, ACIUCN and WCPA.

Marc currently holds the position of IUCN WCPA Vice Chair for Science and Management of Protected Areas. He also served as the lead architect for the concept of the IUCN Green List of Protected Areas, a groundbreaking initiative aiming to establish global standards for effective and equitable management of protected areas. In collaboration with the IUCN and other partners, the concept underwent a pilot phase in eight countries leading up to the 2014 World Parks Congress. The Green List offers an evidence-based method to independently assess the performance of protected areas against established standards and to recognize those that have met all the criteria within the standard.

2. Jon Day

Jon boasts an extensive history of active involvement with IUCN, ACIUCN, and WCPA. Notably, he has authored key publications such as 'Guidelines for applying the IUCN Protected Area Management Categories to Marine Protected Areas' and 'Large Scale MPAs – Guidelines for Design & Management.' With a comprehensive background in planning and managing the Great Barrier Reef, Jon continues to play and active role in world heritage issues globally and ACIUCN.
