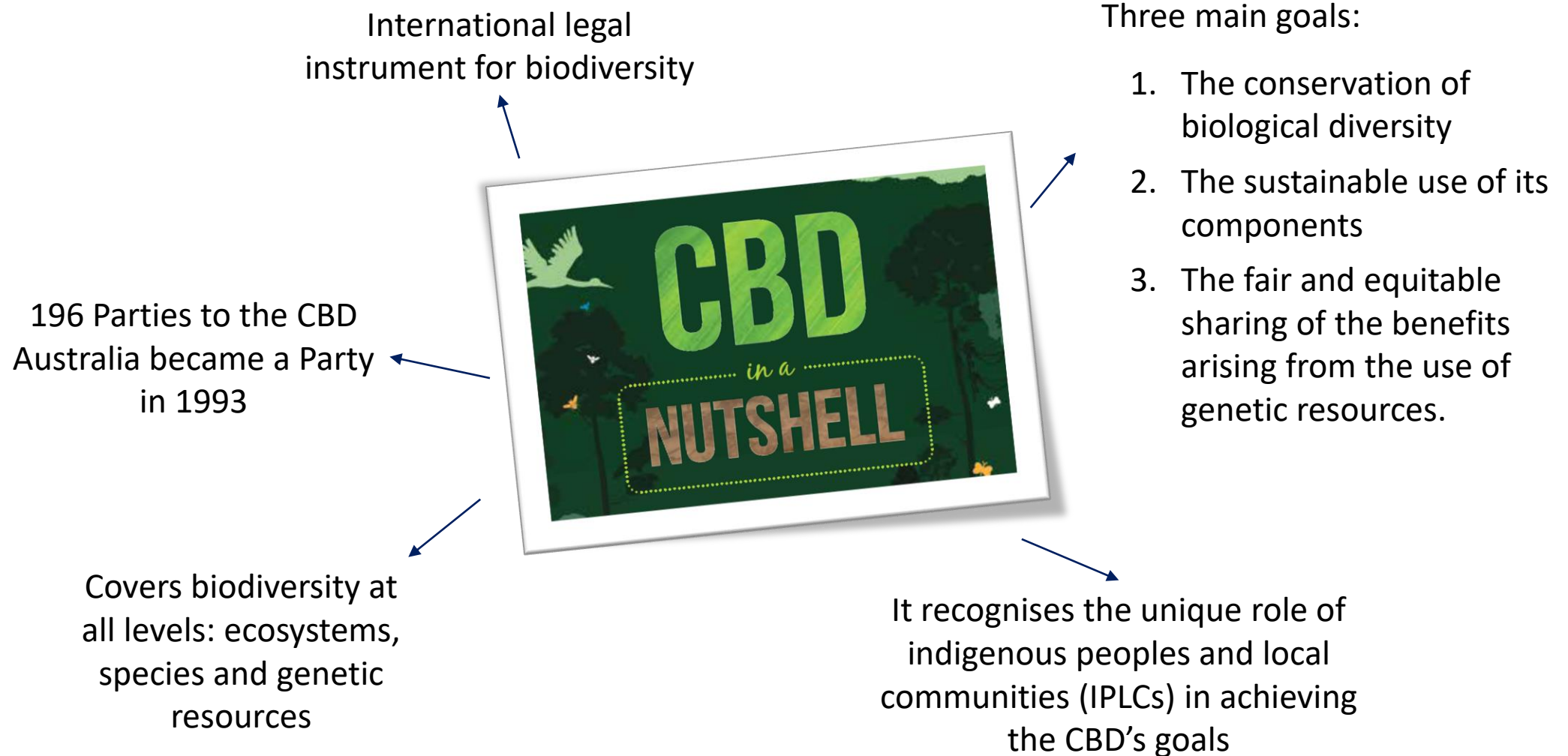

- The strategic plan for the period to 2030.
- Replaces the now expired Aichi Targets, the CBD's strategic plan for 2010-2020.
- Four goals for 2050 and 23 targets for 2030.

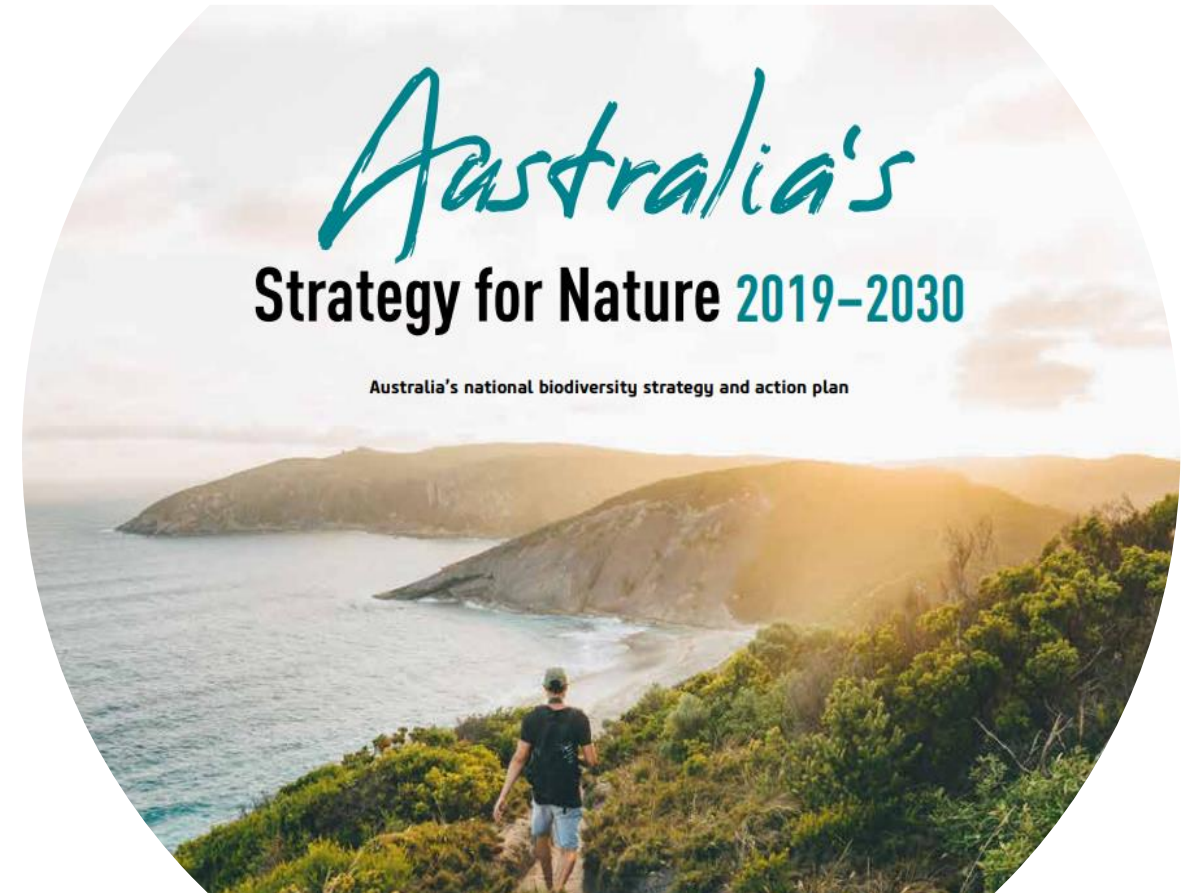
Kunming-Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework: Australia's Priorities
